



Intensive Spoken and Written English Course (Beginner – Advanced)



Course Overview:

The key clients for this qualification are people who wish to undertake the AMES Spoken and Written English Courses in an intensive manner. Unlike the individual courses which are VET courses with required entry points, the ELICOS option allows for thorough testing upon entry, better placement in the most appropriate course, and of course more rapid progress through levels due to the intensive nature of the course. The entry point can be anywhere from “Beginner” to “Intermediate” across the four macro-skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. For learners with a mixed profile, it is possible for them to be enrolled across different levels.

Course Length:

12 months (52 weeks, made up of 40 weeks tuition, and 12 weeks holiday). Students may commence study with induction on any Monday as approved by the Director and general classes operate all weeks except School holiday periods.

Attendance:

Pre-requisites:

We cater for beginners to advance Level. We will determine the most suitable level for you, with the flexibility to move up and down as required.

Delivery Mode:

This ELICOS course is delivered **full time (20 hours per week)** at The Eagle Academy through face to face trainer led classes and supervised tuition/ study sessions. Modules may be delivered and assessed as stand-alone modules or as a combination of modules.

Delivery of the modules may be through text-, topic- or theme-based approaches around the 4 macro-skills of speaking, reading, writing and listening English. Discourse features, grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, and graphology are taught within these contexts. Learners may study modules at different Certificate levels, in particular when there is a difference in proficiency in macro-skills. In order to facilitate this, The Eagle Academy may offer specialist classes, specific modules from another Certificate level to groups of learners, alternative delivery modes if approved by the Director or authorised member of staff.
