- Course Description:** The key clients for this course are people who wish to undertake a non AQF award Spoken and Written English course in an intensive manner. The entry point can be anywhere from “Beginner” to “Intermediate” across the four macro skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. For learners with a mixed profile, it is possible for them to be enrolled across different levels.
- Course Length:** 12 months (52 weeks: 40 weeks tuition + 12 weeks holiday)
- Mode of Study:** Full Time (face to face)
- Hours per Week:** Full time: 20 hours per week. Students are not expected to complete additional study however, we recommend at least 2 hours per week of “other study” comprising of self-study or group study.
- Commencement:** Any Monday of academic term. See Academic Calendar on our website download page.

- Pre-requisites:** There are no pre-requisites. We cater for beginners to advance Level. We will determine the most suitable level for you, with the flexibility to move up and down as required.
- Inclusions:** This course is available at Brisbane and Gold Coast locations. More course and campus information can be found on the All Course and Campus Quick Guide. The fees include everything that students require to complete the course.

- Visa Students:** Be aware that agents can act on our behalf to recruit students. These agents are listed on our website. As this is an approved ELICOS course, the Visa conditions require you to attend 20 hours face to face course schedule hours per week. - Modules:** Delivery of the modules may be through text, topic or theme-based approaches around the 4 macro-skills of speaking, reading, writing and listening English. Discourse features, grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, and graphology are taught within these contexts. Learners may study modules at different Certificate levels, particularly when there is a difference in proficiency in macro skills. To facilitate this, The Eagle Academy may offer specialist classes, specific modules from another Certificate level to groups of learners, alternative delivery modes if approved by the Director or authorised member of staff.
At completion of study, students will receive an ELICOS Certificate stating the level achieved.
